### TRAINING AS A NURSING SPECIALIST (3 YEARS)

with European recognition and in the fields of

- Inpatient long-term care (nursing home)
- Inpatient acute care (hospital) or
- Outpatient acute and long-term care (outpatient nursing service)

Nursing specialists care for and look after sick people in need of care - in hospitals, nursing homes or outpatient services. They carry out medical diagnosis, therapy or rehabilitation measures independently according to medical instructions and work together with doctors, therapists, relatives, patients and residents.

The school-based training is the same for all professional fields of nursing. In practical training, the focus varies depending on with whom the future nursing specialists sign an employment contract.

### STRUCTURE OF THE TRAINING

- The training lasts three years and consists of a part of practice in a nursing home, hospital or outpatient nursing service (2,500 hours) and a part of theory in the BZPG (1,200 hours) and an assignment in psychiatric nursing and in paediatric nursing.
- Part-time training is possible, the training then lasts four years.
- The training concludes with a state examination.
- All trainees receive a training salary.
- Teaching & learning materials are provided free of charge.
- In cooperation with the Niederrhein University of Applied Sciences, we offer the dual study programme „Nursing B.Sc.

### FUTURE PROSPECTS

You have a wide range of job opportunities after the training:

- Hospitals, university and specialist clinics
- Care facilities
- Outpatient care services
- Among others.

### PREREQUISITES FOR TRAINING

- At least intermediate school leaving certificate
- Secondary school leaving certificate (grade 9) plus a successfully completed
  - At least two years of vocational training
  - At least one year of assistant or helper training in nursing care
- other successfully completed ten years of general school education.

- certified copy of the school leaving certificate
- Proof of recognition of the foreign school leaving certificate by the district government
- Proof of already completed vocational training (if available)
