In everyday care, the individual, holistic care of elderly people is often neglected. This is particularly detrimental to the quality of life of people with mental illness or dementia. In order to activate the senses and memory, trained caregivers provide suitable activities. They have time for conversations and provide emotional support and orientation.

## CONTENTS

### Module 1 Basic course

- basic knowledge of communication and interaction
- dealing with people with dementia, mental illnesses and intellectual disabilities
- behaviour in an emergency
- basic knowledge of dementia diseases as well as typical old-age diseases such as diabetes mellitus and degenerative diseases of the musculoskeletal system
- basic knowledge of care and care documentation as well as hygiene requirements for care activities.

### Module 2 Practical training

- practical training in care in a nursing home under the guidance and supervision of a nursing professional experienced in the care and support of the group of persons concerned (the 2-week practical training can be started at the beginning of the course and must be completed on the penultimate day of the further training and must be proven in writing).

### Module 3 Advanced course

- Deepening knowledge, methods and techniques about behaviour, communication and manners with people in need of care
- Home economics and dietetics
- Employment opportunities and leisure activities in biographical care.

## GOALS

The participants develop a professional attitude in dealing with people suffering from dementia, which is characterised by an accepting view of human beings. They can motivate people in need of care and promote the well-being of those affected.
