TRAINING AS A NURSING ASSISTANT (1 YEAR)

with European recognition and in the fields of

- In-patient long-term care (nursing home)
- In-patient acute care (hospital) or
- Outpatient acute and long-term care (outpatient care service)

Nursing assistants support nursing professionals in performing nursing tasks in hospitals, nursing homes or outpatient services. They carry out the orders of the nursing staff professionally under appropriate supervision, document the measures carried out and pass on necessary information.

The school-based training is the same for all occupational fields of nursing. In practical training, the focus varies, depending on with whom the future nursing assistants conclude an employment contract.

STRUCTURE OF THE TRAINING

- The training lasts one year and consists of a practical part in a nursing home, hospital or outpatient care service (950 hours) and a theoretical part in the BZPG (700 hours).
- The training ends with a state examination.
- All trainees receive a training salary.
- Teaching and learning materials are provided free of charge.
- Under certain conditions, the successfully completed one-year assistant training course can be credited towards the three-year nursing training course

FUTURE PROSPECTS

You have a wide range of employment opportunities after completing your training:

- Hospitals, university and specialist clinics
- Nursing homes
- Outpatient care services
- And others.

PREREQUISITES FOR TRAINING

- personal and health aptitude
- secondary school leaving certificate or equivalent school education or completed vocational training

- certified copy of school leaving certificate
- Proof of recognition of the foreign school leaving certificate by the district government
- Proof of vocational training already completed (if available)
- Certificate from a practical training provider (if available)
